
Allocation Programs

INCITE



- The INCITE program receives 60% of the available hours on Summit annually
- In 2020, INCITE consumed 22,455,974 node hours on Summit by 39 awarded projects.

ALCC



- The ASCR Leadership Computing Challenge (ALCC) program receives 20% of the available hours on Summit annually
- In 2020 ALCC consumed 6,524,243 node hours on Summit by 52 awarded projects (ALCC 2020 + ALCC 2021)
 - In 2020, the ALCC program provided the hours for the HPC COVID-19 Consortium which allocated 21 projects and 2,328,000 node hours

ECP



- The OLCF provides resources for the ECP AD and ST teams for their work in preparing for Frontier Access.
- In CY 2020 the OLCF provided 1,912,122 Summit Node hours in support of the ECP goals.
- Up to 10% of the allocable hours



The Director's Discretionary Program

- Open year-round and reviewed on a rolling basis
- Typical maximums are 20k Summit node hours for 1 year duration
- Designed for porting, development, etc.
